A NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR



Dearest friends and families of Audubon United Methodist Church,

I miss you...

I miss hugging each one of you, especially the hugs and blessings I share with each one of you at the end of worship services. When I hug you, I hug you with my love. When I bless you, I bless you with my heart. I am sure that the time is coming and I hope that it won't be long. I am sure that it has not been easy for you to stay at home with not much connection with your loved ones and friends and even your neighbors as you used to. I am sure that it's been frustrating to feel that you have to avoid people. Some of you might have felt guilty when you reacted in a very strange way to others. I am with you. I do pray for all of us faithfully and wholeheartedly.

We do not know yet, as of May 23, 2020, when we will be able to get to our sanctuary to worship together. One of the frustrating things lately is the fact that we cannot plan anything for we do not know when everything will be cleared and safe enough to do the things we would want to do and be used to do. As I have said, when our New Jersey State officials declare that we can gather in the church building, our Church Council will discuss when we will begin to worship in our sanctuary and how we would worship to keep everyone safe. We are working on our own safety manual for it. Yes,

things will be very different than before. Our normal will not be the same at least for a while. I, however, promise you that we will congregate to worship and to fellowship as soon as possible. We will make our facility safe and sound. Until then, our church leaders will continue to do our best to provide the spirit filled worship online, the good learning opportunities, and the warm comforts you need. Let's continue to be patient and keep taking good care of our soul, mind, and body.

One thing I would like to encourage you to think and do, is to find the things that you can learn from this challenging time we are going through. Let's get something out of this challenge in our hands at the end of the tunnel. It does not have to be a big thing but something you can say to yourself that I learned this from this experience and knowing this will help me to grow and prepare for other challenges. I hope you write them down somewhere so that you can go back to read it when you need to. From time to time, I may question you.

However, we are making the best of a bad situation with our online services. Perhaps it is because we are not meeting together that giving is **down 24%** this year as compared to last year. Regardless, our expenses continue. They do not take a break because we are not able to join together each week. We truly appreciate that many of you have continued to send in your weekly or monthly tithes and offerings. If you have not done so, and are able, please send your contributions to the church office as regularly as you are able. You may either mail it or drop it in the church mailbox, which is locked and is located in front of the church house.

In the alternative, you may take advantage of the other methods of giving as described below.

There are several other ways to continue to financially support AUMC while we are apart:

1. If you would like to try **electronic giving**, with your smart phone, tablet or iPad, simply download the app. Search for **Vanco Payments**  **Mobile Access** and download and install the app. It will show up on your device as **GivePlus**. Open the **GivePlus** app and search for our church with our zip code 08106. Once you

have the app, you can either create an account or choose to give "one time." You can also choose to give through your credit card or through your bank account. Simply follow the prompts.

2. If you would like to **continue to give electronically**, fill out the Electronic Giving Form for **Vanco** and mail to Carol Tait.

3. You can go to our website, www.audubonumc.com and click on the link to give link there. Again, you can either use your bank account or a credit card.

The Haddonfield HomeWorks office is located on Kings Highway across from the Municipal Building. This is the fourth office that has been set up in NJ in the last 4 years. Besides Deb Wiersman, the staff includes Mary Ann Taglioli, who has 20 + years of aide experience, along with Terra Tilden, the Director of Nursing, who oversees two dozen nursing aides.

HomeWorks offers a variety of senior in-home care services including personal care (bathing, dressing, skilled nursing, & exercising), companion care (light housework, meal prep, & errands), and memory/dementia care services, if needed. In addition to those services, they offer a stepping-stone service of Family Connect when family members simply want someone to check in on a loved one through the week. They also offer

another way to keep tabs on family members virtually via an in-home monitoring system.
