Book Club



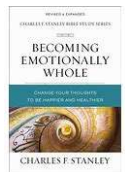
The next meeting of the Book Club will be following worship on March 19 following church service. If you are interested in joining, please see Pastor Garrett.

Carl Ellinwood Jr.

Carl Ellinwood Jr. is an Elementary Music Teacher for Audubon Public Schools in Audubon, NJ and as a Tenor Section Leader for the Mendelssohn Chorus of Philadelphia, and the Greater Philadelphia Choral Society. Prior to his current positions,



Carl was involved in the Washington, D.C. area where he served as an Elementary Music Teacher for St. Mary's County Public Schools, the Artistic Director of the St. Mary's Children's Chorus, the Children's Branch of St. Mary's Choral Arts, and was the 2016 guest conductor for the St. Mary's County Elementary Honors Chorus. Carl is coming to us from his previous church as a Chorister for the Church of the Holy Trinity in Philadelphia, PA.

As a singer, Carl has performed as a soloist and chorister in the Washington DC area and Philadelphia. Professional ensembles include the Washington Master Chorale, Choralis, the Washington National Cathedral, and the Old Presbyterian Meeting House in Alexandria, VA, where he also served as the Children's Choral Director. In Philadelphia, Carl has sung with Opera Philadelphia, Philadelphia Singers, and the Mendelssohn Club of Philadelphia.

Carl received his Bachelors of Arts in Music and Bachelors of Arts in Radio/TV/Film at Rowan University. He also has a Masters of Arts in Music Education from Marywood University and a Masters of Arts in Kodaly Music Education from Loyola University.

Some of you may remember Carl when he attended AUMC as a child and teen.

Carl begins on Sunday March 12. There will be a reception following service that day so you will have an opportunity to say hello.

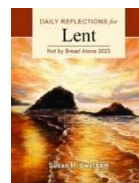

David Akers is an American former football placekicker who played in the National Football League (NFL) for 16 seasons, primarily with the Philadelphia Eagles, where he spent 12 seasons. Akers was also a member of the San Francisco 49ers and Detroit Lions before retiring in 2013.



During his career, Akers was named to six Pro Bowls and twice received first-team All-Pro honors. He also tied the then-NFL record for the longest successful field goal when he converted a 63-yard field goal, which is the third-longest in league history. Akers is an inductee of the Eagles Hall of Fame and a member of the Eagles' 75th Anniversary Team, along with being named to the second-team of the NFL 2000s All-Decade Team.

David's faith has become increasingly stronger. Once only guided by Christ, David is still guided but now also leads. A licensed Reverend, he has performed baptisms and a wedding ceremony, and has given Christian messages to audiences both large and small. As a professional athlete, he remains a very active member of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes and performed pregame team prayers and chapels for the 49ers



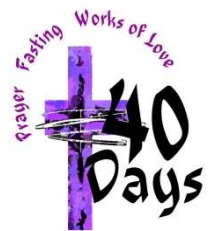

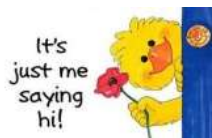
What are you giving up for Lent?

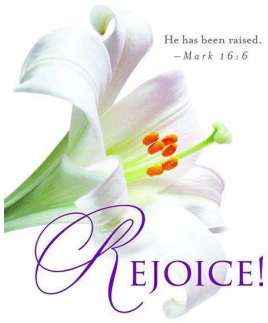
